ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Respondent filed a letter on January 9, 1967, wherein it requests an extension of time within which to pay the fine of \$6,624.94 imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 71514, dated November 9, 1966. The letter asserts that respondent has billed various shippers for undercharges ordered to be collected by said decision; that the shipper involved in the majority of the undercharges has informed respondent that it is reviewing the balance due bills and will remit payment within the next thirty days; that respondent will not have funds available to pay the fine until the undercharges are collected; and that respondent has been unable to negotiate a loan to pay the fine.

It appears to the Commission that respondent should be granted an extension of time to February 28, 1967 within which to pay the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of said decision.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for complying with ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 71514, dated November 9, 1966, is extended to and including February 28, 1967.
