In the Matter of the Application of MARY ANN COE, Executrix of the Estate of HAROLD H. COE, and MARY F. MOSS, doing business as CARL INGALLS TRUCKING COMPANY, for authority to suspend operations as a highway common carrier.

<u>OPINION</u>

Mary Ann Coe as executrix of the estate of Harold H. Coe, deceased, and Mary F. Moss, doing business as Carl Ingalls Trucking Company, request authority to suspend operations as a highway common carrier for a period of one year.

The operating authority was granted by Decision No. 48291 dated February 17, 1953, in Application No. 33392 and authorizes the transportation of property necessary or incidental to the establishment, maintenance or dismantling of oil, gas or water wells, pipe lines, refineries and cracking or casing head plants; material and equipment used in the construction of roads, dams and bridges; and material and equipment used in the construction of and destined for power and compressor plants, between various points within the state.

It is alleged that Harold Coe died on October 10, 1966, and Mary Ann Coe was duly appointed executrix of his estate; Mary F. Moss, the surviving partner cannot operate the business alone and it would be in the public interest to suspend operations while an attempt is made to locate an able and experienced buyer.

A. 48969 ab After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. ORDER IT IS ORDERED that: 1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Harold H. Coe and Mary F. Moss, by Decision No. 48291, dated February 17, 1953, in Application No. 33392 is hereby suspended until February 1, 1968. 2. Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to amend its tariffs on file with the Commission in which Harold H. Coe and Mary F. Moss, doing business as Carl Ingalls Trucking Company, is shown as a participating carrier to indicate that the operative right of said carrier is under suspension pursuant to order of the Commission. 3. Tariff publications authorized and directed to be made as a result of the order herein shall be made effective not earlier than five days and not later than sixty days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public. The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Mary Ann Coe, Executrix of the -2A. 48969 ab

Estate of Harold H. Coe, deceased, Mary F. Moss and Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known addresses as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after completion of such service or of the above mailing unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
