In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing construction at grade of two industrial tracks across Hansen Way, in the City of Redwood City, County of San Mateo, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Hansen Way in Redwood City, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. EA-27.17-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement between the parties relative thereto. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
