ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING

By Decision No. 69419, dated July 21, 1965, Pomona Valley Water Company was granted authority to acquire certain public utility properties and a certificate to serve additional territory. Ordering paragraph 11 of that decision required that applicant file original cost and depreciation reserve requirement studies applicable to the facilities to be acquired. It also provides that when such filings have been made that the matter may be reopened for further hearings to determine: the property used and useful, the appropriate rates for irrigation service, the amount of stock to be issued, and the appropriate accounting for the facilities to be acquired.

Applicant having filed the required studies, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the above titled Application No. 46912 is hereby reopened for further hearing for the purposes set forth in ordering paragraph 11 of Decision No. 69419. Further public hearings shall be held before such Commissioner or Examiner as may be designated at a time and place to be determined.

The Secretary is directed to cause certified copies of this order to be served upon the parties to this proceeding, and to cause appropriate notice of hearing to be mailed to such parties at least ten days before the date of such hearing.
