OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 68502, dated January 19, 1965, in Application No. 47161, and Decision No. 70302, dated February 1, 1966, in Application No. 48094, as amended by Decision No. 70326, dated February 8, 1966, Signal Trucking Service, Ltd. was authorized to suspend warehouse operations in the Cities of Long Beach, Wilmington and San Francisco until February 15, 1967. It is herein requested that the suspension of service be extended to February 15, 1968.

It is alleged that the facts which justified the original suspension still exist and despite strenuous efforts to procure suitable warehouse properties in the cities where operations are authorized, at a rental which will permit applicant to earn a reasonable profit, said efforts have been unsuccessful.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the operating authority granted by Decision No. 53787, in Application No. 37761 and Decision No. 57155 in Application No. 40113; and Decision No. 44148 in Application No. 30967, as amended by Decision No. 53580 and supplemental Decision No. 53621 is suspended to and including February 15, 1968.
