It appearing that applicant may not have provided the service improvements within the period of time specified, IT IS ORDERED that the above proceeding is reopened for the following purposes: To inquire into the extent of compliance or noncompliance by applicant with the provisions of prior orders herein, and into the reasons for any noncompliance. To determine whether or not the rates being charged for water service by applicant should be reduced or otherwise modified. 3. To enter any other order or orders that may be appropriate.
