ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING

In Decision No. 70050, issued in this proceeding on December 7, 1965, the Commission authorized applicant to increase rates for water service and directed him to do certain things to improve service by March 31, 1966. On May 10, 1966, the time for compliance was extended to July 31, 1966. On August 2, 1966, time for compliance was further extended to December 31, 1966. It appearing that applicant may not have provided the service improvements within the period of time specified,

IT IS ORDERED that the above proceeding is reopened for the following purposes:

1. To inquire into the extent of compliance or noncompliance by applicant with the provisions of prior orders herein, and into the reasons for any noncompliance.
2. To determine whether or not the rates being charged for water service by applicant should be reduced or otherwise modified.
3. To enter any other order or orders that may be appropriate.

Public Hearing in said reopened proceeding shall be held before such Commissioner or Examiner and at such time and place as may be hereafter designated.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith upon applicant, and to cause notice of hearing to be mailed at least ten days before such hearing.
