ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF FINE

Commission Decision No. 70718, issued herein
May 17, 1966, ordered the respondent to pay a fine of
\$2,353.66 on or before July 18, 1966. The time within which
to pay the fine was extended to December 1, 1966 by Decision
No. 71395, dated October 11, 1966. On December 1, 1966 only
\$1,792.02 had been paid. The staff instituted an investigation
to determine why the remaining fine was not paid on schedule.
It was revealed that the respondent does not have the financial
resources to eliminate the fine in one payment. The staff has
therefore recommended that the respondent be authorized to
pay the remaining fine in installments.

IT IS ORDERED that the remaining fine of \$562.04 imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 70718 may be paid in five monthly installments of \$100 and a sixth installment of \$62.04; the first installment to be paid on or before the 1st of March 1967, and the remaining installments to be paid not later than the first day of each of the five succeeding months.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
