ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an Order of Suspension and Investigation, issued November 9, 1966, certain tariffs of Tahoe Sierra Water Company were suspended, pending hearing and further order of the Commission, until March 12, 1967. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by said date of March 12, 1967.

Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariffs filed by respondent's Advice Letter No. 17 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including September 12, 1967, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
