SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 71977, entered today in Case No. 5432, et al., the Commission found that certain exception ratings should be established in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 5 and 9-B for the transportation of dressed or eviscerated poultry and poultry parts and that the transportation of live poultry should be exempted from the application of the rates named in the Commission's four drayage tariffs. The Commission also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective March 26, 1967, Twentieth Revised Page 4, Third Revised Page 15-A and Eleventh Revised Page 30, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 41363, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
