BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Investigation into the rates, rules, regulations, charges, allowances and practices of all common carriers, highway carriers and city carriers relating to the transportation of property in Los Angeles and Orange Counties (transportation for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5).

Case No. 5435 (Petition for Modification No. 86) (Filed January 16, 1967)

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 71977, entered today in Case No. 5432, et al., the Commission found that certain exception ratings should be established in City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 5 and 9-B for the transportation of dressed or eviscerated poultry and poultry parts and that the transportation of live poultry should be exempted from the application of the rates named in the Commission's four drayage tariffs. The Commission also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 should be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective March 26, 1967, Sixteenth Revised Page 5, Fifth Revised Page 13-A, Second Revised Page 22-B and First Revised Page 22-C, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and such tariff publications shall be made effective not later than March 26, 1967; and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.
- 3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the ratings and rule authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent

necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the ratings and rule published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
