O P I N I O N

San Francisco Warehouse Company requests authority to suspend operation of 10,000 square feet of public utility warehouse space in Emeryville, California.

It is alleged that applicant's public warehouse operations in Emeryville are conducted in 10,000 square feet of warehouse space, pursuant to a prescriptive right determined by the Commission in its order dated July 12, 1960, in Case No. 6612; applicant's lease expired October 31, 1966; applicant anticipates that a number of months may be required for applicant to find suitable space in which to resume operations; and it requests authorization to suspend operations in Emeryville for a period of one year, or until suitable space can be acquired.

After consideration, the Commission finds that the proposed suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted to the extent hereinafter indicated.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman as determined by Commission order dated July 12, 1960,

in Case No. 6612, is hereby suspended until February 1, 1968, or until the date service is resumed when such date is prior to February 1, 1968, and the Commission is so informed.

2. All effective tariff schedules of San Francisco Warehouse Company, filed pursuant to the operative right granted by the Commission order referred to above, are hereby suspended as provided in ordering paragraph 1 hereof. Suspension supplements to tariff schedules so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
