ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING

Decision No. 68156, issued in this proceeding on November 2, 1964, denied the application without prejudice and rescinded Decision No. 66742, dated February 4, 1964, since it found that the proposed transfer would be adverse to the public interest.

It appears that, notwithstanding Decision No. 68156, the Visalia portion of the water system may have been sold to Horace and Lucille M. Nish.

IT IS ORDERED that the above proceeding be reopened for the following purposes:

1. To inquire as to whether an unauthorized transfer of public utility plant has occurred.

2. To determine whether a transfer of the Visalia system to Horace Nish and Lucille M. Nish would now be in the public interest.

3. To determine total company earnings in connection with the present rate filing, Application No. 48628, for the Tulare portion of Tulco Water Co.

4. To enter any other order or orders that may be appropriate.

The reopened proceeding shall be consolidated with Application No. 48628 for public hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner and at such time and place as may be hereafter designated.
