SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 64211, dated September 6, 1962, authorized applicant to file a schedule of increased rates, which were filed and became effective October 23, 1962. The decision also provided that if the utility connected an additional water supply and installed certain storage and pipeline facilities by September 11, 1963, the Commission would by supplemental order authorize the utility to file the schedule of further increased rates attached to that order as Appendix C. The time for compliance was subsequently extended to September 11, 1966 by Commission order dated November 9, 1965.

By letter dated January 12, 1967, applicant advised the Commission that said improvements had been made. Field investigation by a staff engineer confirms that the required installations have been completed and are satisfactory; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Francis B. Mathews, doing business as Occidental Water Works, is authorized to file with this Commission, after the effective date of this order, the schedules of rates set forth in Appendix C of Decision No. 64211. The effective date of these tariff sheets shall be four days after the date of filing.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
