ORDER AMENDING DECISION  
AND DENYING REHEARING

Petition for rehearing of Decision No. 71801 having been filed by the Southern Pacific Company, the Commission having considered each and every allegation thereof and being of the opinion that no good cause for rehearing has been made to appear, but that certain amendments should be made therein,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 71801 is amended as follows:

Finding No. 3 is deleted and the following language is inserted therefor:

"3. In the absence of an agreement to the contrary, the costs of construction and protection at Crossing No. 6C-6.06 shall be borne one hundred per cent by the Cities of Vernon and Huntington Park, and all of the costs of protection at Crossing No. 6C-6.09 shall be borne fifty per cent by the Railroad and fifty per cent by the Cities of Vernon and Huntington Park."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 71801, as amended herein, is denied.
