ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Applicant has requested an extension of time within which to exercise the authority granted in Decision No. 64888, alleging that the area is still not as yet ready for railroad service even though the track crossing has been completed. The crossing protection has not been completed and accordingly the crossing has been so barricaded that trains cannot operate thereover. Applicant is unable to determine the time when those shipping interests intending to locate in the area will install their facilities and require use of the railroad services.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant may exercise the authority granted in said decision is hereby extended to February 5, 1970.

In all other respects, Decision No. 64888 shall remain in full force and effect.
