S U P P L E M E N T A L   O R D E R

The City of Riverside is hereby authorized to create a temporarily impaired vertical clearance of 21'6" above top of rail during reconstruction of the existing grade separation of Olivewood Avenue (Crossing No. 3-55.9-A) over the track of the Union Pacific Railroad Company in the City of Riverside as authorized by Decision No. 71307, dated September 20, 1966, and the Union Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to operate adjacent thereto provided it retains in position the existing teltales installed at both sides of the structure and further provided that it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and engine men advising them of the impaired clearance and forbidding trainmen to ride the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

In all other respects, Decision No. 71307, dated September 20, 1966, in Application No. 48695, filed August 8, 1966, shall remain in full force and effect.
