ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity of Hartmann Bros. Farm Enterprises has been suspended since July 29, 1966, for failure to file an annual report of its common carrier operations as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code. To date, the carrier has not filed the required annual report.

Hartmann Bros. Farm Enterprises having failed to file the required annual report, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate and cancellation of the above carrier's participation in the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a cement carrier granted to Hartmann Bros. Farm Enterprises by Resolution No. 13823, Sub. No. 25, dated June 23, 1964, in Application No. 46538 is hereby revoked.

2. C. R. Nickerson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Hartmann Bros. Farm Enterprises from Pacific Coast Tariff Bureau, Local Freight Tariff No. 9, Cal.P.U.C. No. 30, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to

be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Hartmann Bros. Farm Enterprises or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Hartmann Bros. Farm Enterprises or after the above mailing to it unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
