ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Kidd's Communications, Inc. having on February 10,
1967 requested, in writing, an extension of the time limit to
refile tariffs mentioned in Ordering Paragraph No. 4 of Decision
No. 71583, dated November 29, 1966, because of recent abnormal
weather conditions which required excessive maintenance time to
keep the system operating and the unexpected illness of key
operating personnel, and it appearing to the Commission that the
extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for compliance with
Ordering Paragraph No. 4, of Decision No. 71583, is extended to
and including May 1, 1967.

In all other respects, Decision No. 71583 shall remain
in full force and effect.
