amended November 14, 1966)ORDER DENYING REHEARING

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 71861, which decision denied petitioner's application for a certificate authorizing him to operate a passenger stage service between Los Angeles and San Ysidro, has been filed by Octavio Martinez, doing business as Los Angeles Bus Line.

Section 1032 of the Public Utilities Code provides that a certificate may be granted to a new passenger stage applicant only when the existing corporations serving the applicant's proposed territory will not provide service to the satisfaction of the Commission. In the instant case, the Commission found on sufficient evidence that the existing service is satisfactory and that protestants have Spanish-speaking personnel available. See Decision 71482, dated October 25, 1966, in Applications Nos. 47365 and 47382, Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., et al.

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing is denied.
