O R D E R

The City of National City is hereby authorized to construct 24th Street at grade across tracks of San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in National City, San Diego County, at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 36B-5.66.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by three Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) with additional flashing lights on cantilever arms, and a "No Left Turn" train activated neon sign shall be installed in the median in the northeast quadrant of the crossing.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions

of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
