OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier and highway contract carrier permits. By this application, it seeks exemption from the provisions of General Order No. 84-F, under which carriers may not handle C.O.D. shipments until a bond of not less than \$2,000 is provided and filed with the Commission. The sought exemption would apply only in connection with shipments transported for the shipper hereinafter designated. The application is accompanied by a letter from Simmons Company stating in effect that the bonding of applicant is not necessary in connection with its C.O.D. consignments.

General Order No. 84-F contains bonding requirements and additional provisions governing the handling of C.O.D. shipments. The bonding provisions are set forth in Ordering Paragraphs 2 to 7, inclusive. Corresponding provisions are set forth in minimum rate tariffs of the Commission.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
