OPINION

Donald Eiden and Margaret Eiden filed this application for a household goods carrier permit. Mrs. Eiden was given two examinations as required by Section 5135 of the Public Utilities Code. She failed to pass these examinations. However, according to the staff member who examined her she has an adequate knowledge of the piece rates.

As required by Section 5135 a public hearing was held at Los Angeles before Examiner Power on November 16, 1966, and the matter was submitted.

It appears, and the Commission finds, that applicants meet the requirement for issuance of a permit, provided that such permit is restricted to service between points in Orange County and to the established piece rates.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as provided by the following order.

A. 48842 ds ORDER IT IS ORDERED that the Secretary of the Commission is authorized and directed to issue a household goods carrier permit to Donald Eiden and Margaret Eiden containing the following restriction: "Applicants shall not perform any transportation service under this permit where either the point of origin or the point of destination is outside of the boundaries of Orange County and shall be limited to the piece rates as prescribed in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B and supplements thereto or successive reissues thereof."
