ORDER RESCINDING BALANCE OF FINE

By letter filed February 8, 1967, respondent requests that he be relieved from paying the balance due on the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 70434 dated March 8, 1966, as amended. The fine of \$4,549.99 imposed by said decision was reduced \$42.68 by Decision No. 71396 dated October 11, 1966. The balance due on the fine is \$360.09 which represents the remaining undercharges ordered to be collected by respondent. The letter asserts that respondent has been unable to collect the balance of the undercharges from the estate of the deceased shipper responsible therefor.

It appears to the Commission that the balance of \$360.09 due on the fine should be rescinded.
