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AMENDING DECISION AND EXTENDING TIME

The County of San Diego has requested an Order of the Commission granting an extension of time in order to comply with Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 with respect to Chesterfield Drive, Crossing No. 2-239.8, in Decision No. 71344 in Case No. 8326 dated October 4, 1966. The County proposes to construct a grade separation at a nearby location which would permit the closing of the Chesterfield Drive grade crossing, thereby making any of the ordered improvements of temporary nature. The Chesterfield Drive grade crossing was ordered to be widened and improved with automatic crossing gates within one year of the effective date in Decision No. 71344. Ordering Paragraph 3 in that decision required that Montgomery Avenue, Crossing No. 2-239.3 be closed to vehicular traffic and physically removed upon the completion of the improvements at Chesterfield Drive.

The County and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway

Company have informed the Commission that they are not opposed to the

closure of Montgomery Avenue grade crossing at the present time.
