ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct two additional spur tracks at grade across Grand Avenue in Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6A-4.53. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant states that the industry to be served by the proposed spur tracks desires service by April 12, 1967.
