OPINION AND ORDER

Giacomazzi Bros. Transportation Co., a corporation, holds radial highway common carrier, highway contract carrier, petroleum contract carrier and city carrier permits. By Decision No. 70853 dated June 14, 1966, in Application No. 48440, applicant was authorized to charge a rate less than the established minimum rate for the transportation of waste lime for Spreckels Sugar Company from Spreckels to a point near Mendota. The authorized rate is 21½ cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 45,000 pounds per unit of carrier's equipment. The current authority is scheduled to expire with March 31, 1967.

By this application, applicant seeks an extension of the current authority to and including June 30, 1967, for the reason that teamster negotiations are pending and the spring lime haul may extend beyond March 31, 1967.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 27, 1967. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds that extension of the expiration date, as requested, is justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted. In view of the impending expiration date of the current authority, the order which follows will be made effective March 31, 1967.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Giacomazzi Bros. Transportation Co., a corporation, is authorized to transport waste lime for Spreckels Sugar Company from that company's plant at Spreckels to its plant near Mendota at a rate less than the established minimum rate but not less than the rate set forth below, subject to the conditions hereinafter indicated:

- (a) The applicable rate shall be 21-3/4 cents per 100 pounds, minimum weight 45,000 pounds per unit of equipment consisting of a tractor and two flat-rack trailers equipped with specially constructed boxes.
- (b) When the total time involved in loading and unloading on any single trip exceeds two hours, the accessorial charge set forth in Item No. 145 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 shall be assessed for the total time in excess of two hours.
- (c) The surcharges applicable to transportation involving the Central Coastal Territory shall not be applicable.
- (d) In all other respects, the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 shall be applicable.

2. The authority herein granted shall, on and after March 31, 1967, supersede the authority granted by Decision No. 70853 and shall expire with June 30, 1967.

The effective date of this order shall be March 31, 1967.
