Application of the County of Sacramento to reconstruct a grade crossing of The Western Pacific Railroad Company at Elkhorn Boulevard.	}	Application No. 49148 (Filed February 15, 1967)
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ORDER

The County of Sacramento is hereby authorized to relocate the crossing of Elkhorn Boulevard at grade with a track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, Crossing No. 4-146.3 near Del Paso, Sacramento County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-seven feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Construction expense of the crossing shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Construction expense of the automatic protection shall be borne 50 percent by the County of Sacramento and 50 percent by The Western Pacific Railroad Company. Maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. The Western Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be divided 50 percent to the railroad and 50 percent to the county pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Upon completion and opening to traffic of the relocated crossing, the existing crossing shall be abandoned and effectively barricaded.

The relocated crossing shall not be opened to public use until the protection ordered herein is installed and operative.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant advised that it desires to advertise for bids on the road construction including the relocated crossing as early as possible and requests immediate authorization. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
