ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

On March 14, 1967, the Commission ordered an investigation on its own motion, Case No. 8609, of the California Water & Telephone Company and other telephone corporations on the following subjects: (1) separations procedures affecting the toll and other settlements of respondents therein; (2) multi-message unit rates of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company in the Los Angeles Extended Area and extended area rates affecting the rates of any of the respondents therein; (3) toll rate disparities between interstate and intrastate message toll rates affecting any of the respondents therein; (4) any disparity between exchange rates of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company and the respondents therein; (5) directory advertising rates as requested by The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company to the extent that they may affect respondents therein; and any plans for splitting telephone directories in California to the extent that they may affect any of the respondents therein.

The investigation in Case No. 7452, substantially having been replaced by the investigation in Case No. 8609, will be discontinued.
