S U P P L E M E N T A L O R D E R

The City of Antioch is hereby authorized to create a temporarily impaired vertical clearance of 21'6" above top of rail during construction of a crossing at separated grades of "H" Street over the track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Antioch, Contra Costa County, as authorized by Decision No. 70849, dated June 14, 1966, and Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to operate adjacent thereto provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and engine men advising them of the impaired clearance and forbidding trainmen to ride the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

In all other respects, Decision No. 70849, dated June 14, 1966, in Application No. 48375, shall remain in full force and effect.
