ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF FINE

Decision No. 71739, herein dated December 21, 1966 ordered the respondent to pay a fine of \$6,207.61, not later than February 5, 1967.

The Commission received a letter dated January 5, 1967 from the respondent wherein he advised that his hauling is seasonal and starts in April; that heavy taxes and license fees become due in the months of January through March and that the undercharge collections out of which most of the fine is to be paid will not start coming in for several weeks; it was requested that payment of the fine be deferred until April 5, 1967, when \$1,000 can be paid, and that the remainder of the fine be paid in \$500 monthly installments.

Respondent's request was held in abeyance during the pendancy of his petition for rehearing which stayed the effect of Decision No. 71739.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the fine of \$6,207.61 imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 71739 may be paid in installments, as follows: \$1,000 to be paid not later than May 1, 1967 and \$500 to be paid not later than the first day of each of the ten succeeding months. The final sum of \$207.61 to be paid on or before the first day of the eleventh month as a last installment.

In all other respects Decision No. 71739 shall remain in full force and effect.
