O P I N I O N

South Tahoe Moving & Storage, Inc., requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman in the vicinity of the City of South Lake Tahoe, County of El Dorado, with 17,500 square feet of floor space.

Applicant has negotiated a long-term lease on a warehouse building located approximately 100 yards outside of the city limits of the City of South Lake Tahoe. The building is three years old and is constructed of concrete blocks. It has a storage capacity of 17,500 square feet, of which 15,500 square feet is located on the ground floor and approximately 2,000 square feet is located on the mezzanine of the building. Applicant proposes to conduct a general warehouse business and would store any type of commodity which could be accommodated in the building.

Applicant is presently engaged as a radial carrier and a household goods carrier pursuant to permits issued by this Commission. As of December 31, 1966, applicant indicated a net worth in the amount of \$27,876.29.

It is alleged that the Lake Tahoe area is a rapidly growing and expanding area with 50,000 year-round residents and approximately 100,000 residents during the summer months; to

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applicant's knowledge there is at present no public utility warehouseman operating in the Lake Tahoe area; and a number of persons have requested applicant to establish the proposed service.

According to the application, a copy thereof was served upon the California Warehouseman's Association. No protest to the application has been received.

After consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to South Tahoe Moving & Storage, Inc., a corporation, as a public utility warehouseman, as defined in Section 239(b) of the Public Utilities Code, for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space as set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. Applicant is placed on notice that, if it accepts the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, may result in a cancellation of the public utility warehouse operations authorized by this decision.

- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61-A.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
