ORDER DISCONTINUING  
 INVESTIGATION AND SUSPENSION

Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, on behalf of various carriers participating in certain of its tariffs, petitioned, on February 27, 1967, to suspend rates for the transportation of bakery goods from various points in the Los Angeles Basin Area to San Francisco, Oakland and San Jose by Southern Pacific Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. The rates are published in Item 3525-B of Supplement 49 to Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, Freight Tariff 294-E, filed to become effective March 12, 1967.

By the Commission's order in Decision No. 72123, dated March 9, 1967, in (I & S) Case No. 8597, the rates in issue were suspended until July 11, 1967, pending further investigation therein.

On March 17, 1967, the Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, on behalf of respondent rail carriers, made written request for authority to withdraw and cancel the rates suspended by the Commission's order in Decision No. 72123. In the circumstances, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, will be authorized and directed to cancel the rates in issue and the petition of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau, Agent, is authorized and directed to cancel the rates published in Item 3525-B of Supplement 49 to its Freight Tariff 294-E not later than thirty days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

2. The petition of Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., dated February 27, 1967, in (I & S) Case No. 8597 is dismissed.

3. The investigation contemplated by Case No. 8597 is discontinued.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
