ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 70599 herein, dated April 19, 1966, ordered the installation of No. 8 flashing light signals with automatic gate arms at the 29th Avenue crossing over the tracks of the Western Pacific Railroad Company and the Southern Pacific Company. The flashing light signals were to be coordinated with the traffic signals at the intersection of 29th Avenue and East 12th Street, and all work ordered was to be completed by April 19, 1967.

The Western Pacific Railroad Company filed a petition on March 16, 1967 wherein an extension of time is requested. The petition alleges that various delays have occurred and that plans submitted by the petitioner are still being studied by the City of Oakland.

IT IS ORDERED that the period within which to complete the work ordered by ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 70599 is hereby extended to January 1, 1968.
