ORDER PERMANENTLY SUSPENDING FILING AND DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

Tahoe Sierra Water Company and Tahoe Southside Water Utility have agreed upon a division of tariff serving area requested by Tahoe Sierra Water Company in its suspended tariff map filing under Advice Letter No. 17, which had been protested by Tahoe Southside Water Utility. Both utilities have made tariff map filings effectively dividing the area between the two utilities, Tahoe Southside Water Utility by Advice Letter No. 23, filed March 20, 1967, and Tahoe Sierra Water Company by Advice Letter No. 18, filed March 13, 1967, with each furnishing the other a copy of its filing and neither protesting the filing of the other. By these tariff filings the boundary conflict has been resolved; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Tahoe Sierra Water Company Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 126-W and 127-W are hereby permanently suspended and this proceeding is discontinued.
