ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO PAY FINE

Respondent filed a letter on April 3, 1967, wherein it requests authority to pay the balance of the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 71562, dated November 22, 1966, in monthly installments. A payment of \$500.00 accompanied the letter. The balance due on the fine is \$1,772.63. The letter asserts that due to financial difficulties, respondent does not have sufficient funds available at this time to pay the entire amount due in a single payment and that there are no immediate prospects for an improvement in respondent's financial position.

It appears to the Commission that respondent should be authorized to pay the balance of said fine in monthly installments as provided in the order which follows.

IT IS ORDERED that the balance of \$1,772.63 remaining to be paid on the fine imposed by Decision No. 71562, dated November 22, 1966, may be paid in five monthly installments of
