SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 72186 dated March 21, 1967, in the above proceeding authorized Fred V. Young, doing business as Ferro Brothers Trucking Company, to charge rates which are less than the minimum rates otherwise applicable for the transportation of ice for Fresno Consumers Ice Company from Stockton and Fresno to the field station¹ of California Packing Corporation at Fancher Ranch.

Fred V. Young has informed the Commission by letter that his transportation company was recently incorporated and that radial highway common carrier and highway contract carrier permits have been obtained by Ferro Trucking, the corporation involved. He requests that the above less-than-minimum rate authority be transferred from him to the corporation in order that the corporation may perform the aforementioned transportation service and the permits in his name may be canceled.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the continuation of the present minimum rate deviation in the name of Ferro Trucking, a corporation, is justified. A public

hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Decision No. 72186, supra, should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 72186 dated March 21, 1967, in Application No. 49127 is hereby amended by substituting the following for Ordering Paragraph 1 thereof:

"1. Ferro Trucking, a corporation, is hereby authorized to transport shipments of ice for Fresno Consumers Ice Company from Stockton and Fresno to the field station of California Packing Corporation at Fancher Ranch, located on Yosemite Highway approximately six miles easterly from Merced, at rates less than the minimum rates otherwise applicable but no lower than the following:

Commodity: Ice. Minimum weight 42,000 pounds per shipment.

From Stockton	20
From Fresno	18 "

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 72186 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
