SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It concluded that Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 3-A, 4-B, 5, 9-B and 11-A and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A should be amended by separate orders so as to avoid conflicts in the applications of the minimum rates in said tariffs with the minimum rates established in Minimum Rate Tariff 18; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 1, 1967, Third Revised Page 17, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

Item No. APPLICATION OF TARIFF - COMMODITIES (Concluded) (Items Nos. 50 and 51) Rates in this tariff apply for the transportation of all commodities except the following: Furniture, household appliances and other home furnishings transported from retail stores or retail store warehouses where they have been sold at retail by a retail merchant, or transported from retail customers to retail stores, or retail store warehouses, Houses or sections thereof and integral parts or contents when transported therewith, Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids, in bulk in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semi-trailers or a combination of such highway vehicles, Mushrooms, fresh (not cold pack nor frozen), Newspapers, newspaper supplements, sections or inserts Ø51 (not scrap nor waste), Nuts, in the shell, Nuts, field shelled (rough shelled, with or without removal of broken shells, dirt, residue, or foreign material, and not cleaned nor further processed), Poultry, live, Property shipped to or from producers of motion pictures or television shows when transported subject to the rates, rules and regulations provided by Decision No. 33226, in Cases Nos. 4246 and 4434, as amended, Property of the United States, or property transported under an agreement whereby the United States contracted for the carrier's services, Property transported to a United States Post Office for mailing, United States mail transported from a post office to the addressee thercof, and United States mail transported for the Post Office Department under contract, Telephone directories, *Trailer coaches and campers set up, (including contents and furniture and other personal effects for use outside of trailer coaches) for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff 18,

Used property, viz.: household goods, personal effects, furniture, musical instruments, radios, television sets, and office and store fixtures and equipment as described in and for which rates are provided in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B, and used property as described therein of state, county or municipal governments, or transported under an agreement whereby the governments contracted for the carrier's services,
