SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 72418, issued MAY 16 1967,

the Commission established in Minimum Rate Tariff 18 minimum rates for the transportation by motor vehicle over public highways of trailer coaches, portable campers, and furniture and personal effects included therein. It concluded that Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 2, 3-A, 4-B, 5, 9-B and 11-A and City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A should be amended by separate orders so as to avoid conflicts in the applications of the minimum rates in said tariffs with the minimum rates established in Minimum Rate Tariff 18; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 11-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 50114, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective July 1, 1967, Sixth Revised Page 5, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff page incorporated in this order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

<p style="text-align: center;">APPLICATION OF TARIFF - CARRIERS</p> <p>Rates provided in this tariff are minimum rates established pursuant to the Highway Carriers' Act. They apply for the transportation of uncrated new furniture by radial highway common carriers and highway contract carriers as defined in said act.</p> <p>Rates, rules and regulations named in this tariff shall not apply to transportation by independent-contractor subhaulers when such transportation is performed for other carriers. This exception shall not be construed to exempt from the tariff provisions carriers for whom the independent contractors are performing transportation service.</p>	20
<p style="text-align: center;">APPLICATION OF TARIFF - TERRITORIAL</p> <p>Rates in this tariff apply to transportation of shipments between all points within the State of California, except transportation:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Within incorporated cities; (2) Within or between zones described in the following Commission tariffs: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Minimum Rate Tariff No. 1-B. (b) Los Angeles Drayage Area as described in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. (c) Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B. 	30

<p style="text-align: center;">APPLICATION OF TARIFF - COMMODITIES</p> <p>Rates in this tariff apply to the transportation of uncrated new furniture except:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) When transported from retail stores or retail store warehouses where the property has been sold at retail by a retail merchant, or transported from retail customers to retail stores or retail store warehouses. (2) Property of the United States, state, county or municipal governments or property transported under an agreement whereby the governments contracted for the carrier's services. (3) When transported under the vehicle unit rates, rules and regulations of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 15. 	50

(4) Disaster Supplies, i.e., those commodities which are allocated to provide relief during a state of extreme emergency or state of disaster; and those commodities which are transported for a civil defense or disaster organization established and functioning in accordance with the California Disaster Act to ultimate point of storage or use prior to or during a state of disaster or state of extreme emergency.

* (5) Contents of trailer coaches and campers; furniture and other personal effects for use outside of trailer coaches when transported in conjunction with such vehicles at rates in Minimum Rate Tariff 18.
