SECOND INTERIM ORDER

By Decision No. 71499, dated November 1, 1966 in this proceeding, American Transfer Company was authorized, on an interim basis, to transport crushed dolomite rock for Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company from Kaiser Refractories Quarry, at Natividad, to said glass company's plant at Fresno. The authorization was limited to a period of six months, to permit the development of experience under the rate in question and to receive evidence at a public hearing, on the basis of which to make final disposition of the matter.

Public hearing was held at Fresno on March 30, 1967. Since a final decision in Application No. 48874 may not issue prior to the expiration of the present temporary authority, it appears that said authority should be extended for an additional period of two months. Therefore,

A. 48874 HJH

IT IS ORDERED that the authority granted by Decision No. 71499, which authority expires on May 21, 1967, is extended to July 21, 1967, unless sooner canceled, modified or extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on May 21, 1967.
