ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 68026, dated October 13, 1964, in Application No. 46830, Larry A. Dover, an individual, was granted passenger stage operative rights to transport passengers for sightseeing purposes commencing at 6909 Hollywood Boulevard through certain sections of the County of Los Angeles and Cities of Los Angeles and Beverly Hills on a round trip or circular tour basis only, and it appearing that during the month of May 1966, Larry A. Dover, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him pursuant to the foregoing described operative right, and that since October 29, 1966, Larry A. Dover has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-B, and that Larry A. Dover has expressed his desire to discontinue service due to illness; therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 68026 in Application No. 46830, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Larry A. Dover, an individual, are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Larry A. Dover or to mail a certified copy thereof to Larry A. Dover at 731 No. St. Andrews Place, Los Angeles, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 20th day after such service upon Larry A. Dover or after the above mailing to Larry A. Dover, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
