Decision No. 72463

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of TRANSCONTINENTAL BUS SYSTEM, INC., a corporation, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation authorizing the establishment of an additional route between Oakland and Castro Valley, pursuant to Sections 1031-1036 of the California Public Utilities Code.

OPINION

Transcontinental Bus System, Inc., requests authority to operate over Interstate Highway 580 between Oakland and a point south of Castro Valley on U. S. Highway 50.

It is alleged that Interstate Highway 580 recently has been completed between Oakland and Castro Valley where it connects with U. S. Highway 50; the use of this new freeway will permit applicant to provide a more expeditious and convenient service to its passengers without any increase or decrease in its service or change in its competitive relationship with other passenger stage corporations; its present restriction against local service between San Francisco and Hayward will not be affected; and applicant does not propose to pickup and discharge passengers on Interstate Highway 580.

After consideration the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Appendix A of Decision No. 55018, in Application No. 38350, is amended by incorporating therein First Revised Page 2-A, attached hereto, in revision of Original Page 2-A.
- 2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall amend its tariffs and timetables presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority granted herein.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

1.08 - Between junction U. S. Highway 99 and Lankershim Boulevard (near San Fernando) and Los Angeles:

From junction U. S. Highway 99 and Lankershim Boulevard through North Hollywood, thence over city streets in Los Angeles through Hollywood to the bus depot of Transcontinental Bus System, Inc., in Los Angeles.

*1.09 - Between Oakland and junction U. S. Highway 50 and Interstate Highway 580 south of Castro Valley:

From Oakland over Interstate Highway 580 to its junction with U. S. Highway 50 immediately south of Castro Valley, serving all intermediate points via city streets extending to and from Interstate Highway 580.
