## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 72471 entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 405) et al., amended the rules of Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2, 3-A, 6-A, 8, 10, 11-A, 12 and 14-A by providing that freight charges may be prorated, apportioned or divided between or among carriers.

The decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A should be amended by a separate order in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 14-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 67397, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become offective June 24, 1967, Third Revised Page 18 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than June 24, 1967.

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3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rule authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rule published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 67397, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
