O P I N I O N

Douglas Joseph, Hudson Joseph, Roy Joseph, and Donald I. Joseph, copartners, doing business as Owens Valley Freight Lines, request authority to sell and transfer, and Big Pine Trucking Company, Inc., requests authority to purchase and acquire, a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing operations as a highway common carrier.

Said certificate was granted by Decision No. 52094 dated October 18, 1965, in Application No. 36426 and authorizes the transportation of groceries, grocers' supplies, canned goods and dairy products between Los Angeles and points and places within ten miles thereof, including Long Beach, on the one hand, and Bishop, Lone Pine, Independence, Big Pine and points and places within five miles of said points, on the other hand. The agreed cash consideration is \$500.

Applicant purchaser is presently engaged as a permitted carrier and as of December 31, 1966, indicated a net worth in the amount of \$123,325.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed transfer will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

The authorization herein granted shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the rights and properties herein authorized to be transferred.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. On or before December 1, 1967, Douglas Joseph, Hudson Joseph, Roy Joseph, and Donald I. Joseph may sell and transfer, and Big Pine Trucking Company, Inc. may purchase and acquire, the operative rights and property referred to in the application.

2. Within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, Big Pine Trucking Company, Inc. shall notify the Commission, in writing, of that fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.

3. Big Pine Trucking Company, Inc. shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates and rules governing the common carrier operations herein to show that it has adopted or established, as its own, said rates and rules. The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than thirty days after the effective date of this order on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the consummation of the transfer herein authorized. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80-A.

4. On or before the end of the third month after the consummation of the transfer as herein authorized, Big Pine Trucking Company, Inc. shall cause to be filed with the Commission, in such form as the Commission may prescribe, an annual report, or reports, related to the operations of the sellers for the period commencing with the first day of the current year to and including the effective date of the transfer.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
