ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Respondent filed a letter on May 16, 1967, wherein he requests an extension of time within which to pay the balance of the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 72195, dated March 28, 1967. A payment of \$1,500.00 accompanied the letter. The balance due on the fine is \$1,498.05. The letter asserts that respondent does not have sufficient funds available to pay the entire fine in a single payment.

It appears to the Commission that the time within which respondent is required to pay the balance of said fine should be extended to July 15, 1967.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with the requirements of ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 72195, dated March 28, 1967, is extended to and including July 15, 1967.
