Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing the widening of two existing crossings at separated grades over tracks of the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company in connection with improvement of State Route 8 in the city of El Cajon, referred to as "El Cajon Overhead" and "Marshall Avenue Overhead".

ORDER

State of California, Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to widen two existing crossings at separated grades over the tracks of San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company, in the City of El Cajon, San Diego County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 36D-16.0-A and 36D-17.29-AC. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, a temporary side clearance of not less than 7'6" is authorized and the San Diego and Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to operate with such reduced

clearance provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to trainmen and enginemen advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on the sides of cars while operating beneath the structures.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
