SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER By Decision No. 71692 dated December 13, 1966, in this proceeding, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., was authorized to cancel on behalf of Western Gillette, Inc. (Western) the participation of Western in numerous rail competitive commodity rates on or before July 1, 1967. By letter dated May 11, 1967, applicant seeks a six-month extension of the authority granted by Decision No. 71692. Applicant states that the authorized rate cancellations involve 148 items appearing on 148 tariff pages and would result in prohibitive expense to Western in the event it should have to make special tariff filings canceling each of these items. Applicant asserts that the sought authority would save the carrier considerable money and would have no harmful effect upon shippers inasmuch as these rates have not been used by them for more than a year. In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the extension of the expiration date, as requested, is justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that applicant's request should be granted. -1IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 71692 dated December 13, 1966, in
Shortened Procedure Tariff Docket Application No. 48846 is
hereby amended by substituting for Ordering Paragraph 3 thereof
the following:

"3. The authority herein granted shall expire
unless exercised on or before January 2,
1968."

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 71692 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
