ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this application, Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., for and on behalf of Western Gillette, Inc., (Western) seeks authority to: (1) cancel the point-to-point rates for the transportation of uncrated new furniture between San Francisco, Oakland, Sacramento and Los Angeles, on the one hand, and various points in the Lake Tahoe, Bishop and Stockton areas and Blythe, on the other hand; (2) restrict the application of the point-to-point rates for the aforementioned transportation between San Francisco and Los Angeles Territories so that such rates will not apply from or to intermediate points; and (3) apply, in lieu of the canceled rates, distance rates which are based on a minimum weight of 6,000 pounds.

This proposal is tantamount to a withdrawal from providing uncrated new furniture service under the carrier's certificate. It is not susceptible of handling as a rate matter. The Commission concludes that the application should be dismissed.

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IT IS ORDERED that Shortened Procedure Tariff Docket Application No. 49192 is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
