Southern Pacific Company has requested an extension of time within which to comply with a condition of Decision No. 71484, alleging that it will be impossible to complete the upgrading of protection within the time specified, but that it can be completed within 90 days.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which applicant shall complete the project is hereby extended to August 18, 1967.

In all other respects, Decision No. 71484 shall remain in full force and effect.
