ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision No. 72471, dated May 23, 1965, in Case No. 5432, the rule governing the issuance of shipping documents in Item 255 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 was amended to clearly indicate that the aforesaid tariff rule does not prohibit the prorating, apportioning or dividing of freight charges between or among carriers. The sought relief of George L. Wagner is, therefore, not necessary or otherwise required. Under the circumstances, Application No. 49189 will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 49189 is dismissed.
